In literature, suspense is a feeling of tension and anticipation that keeps the reader engaged and interested in the story's outcome. It can be created by a variety of different techniques, including pacing, foreshadowing, and tension-building.

Pacing

Pacing is the speed at which the story progresses. A slow pace can build tension and create suspense by drawing out the reader's anticipation. Conversely, a rapid pace can create suspense by keeping the reader on edge and forcing them to pay close attention to the story's action.

Foreshadowing

Foreshadowing is a technique in which the author provides hints or clues about future events in the story. This can create suspense by making the reader wonder what will happen next and how the story will come to its conclusion.

Tension-Building

Tension-building is the process of creating an emotional reaction in the reader. By creating emotional turbulence and the feeling of unpredictability, tension building creates suspense in the reader, encouraging them to keep reading to find out what happens next.
